





Poverty Rates of Elderly Dropped While Rates Among Children Rose



Federal Poverty Level, 2013: \$23,550 for family of four

Almost Half of Children Live in Households with Income <2x FPL





Pediatricians routinely make referrals to community services

- 70% food assistance
- 60% housing/transportation
- 40% heat
- 26% employment
- 73% want AAP to provide advocacy opportunities to address public policy issues related to child poverty

Childhood Condition		Adult Outcomes
Low Birth Weight	-	Obesity, type II diabetes, hypertension
Asthma	→	Asthma, airway sensitivity
Obesity	-	Obesity, complications
Toxic Stress		Structural changes in brain: impact memory, exaggerate response to stress; more high risk behaviors; increase inflammatory markers
Low Educational Achievement		Poorer health, increased mortality



Children 0 – 8 yo Living in Low-Income Households (2012)

National: 48% or 17.2M children

Iowa: 40% or 142,000 children

Low-Income 3 and 4 yo not enrolled in Preschool (2009-11)

National average: 45%

Iowa: 61-63%

Action Area	Things Pediatricians Can Do
Advocacy	Letters supporting CHIP reauthorization. Chapter aligns advocacy agenda with partner agencies. Join advocacy committee.
Tool Kits	AAP is creating tool kits to help Pediatricians address poverty-related issues with their families/patients.
Clinical Setting	Work with parent on ways families can mitigate effects of poverty (educational support; discuss limiting exposure to tobacco/drugs; limit screen time)
Address Access Barriers	Participate in telehealth expansion to bring services to rural areas and families with transportation barriers
